



## **Inmagic Content Server v9.00 Service Pack 1**

Purpose: To address the following issues –

1. CS/TextWorks Workgroup no longer displays “Login failed for <username>” on startup, nor when opening or closing a textbase, if the user is not logged in as an Administrator. [SPR 4345]
2. CS/WebPublisher PRO now obtains from the INMCSRV.INI file the sShortDate setting and other date options in the [defaults] section. [SPR 4357]
3. For CS/WebPublisher PRO, specifying secondary KeyFields in XML input no longer generates errors if the link is broken. [SPR 4342]

### **Installation instructions for applying the Content Server v9.00 Service Pack 1**

This service pack is optional. Review the issues addressed to determine if they are relevant to your installation. If so, apply both the CS/TextWorks and CS/WebPublisher PRO components of the service pack. They may be applied in any order.

#### **CS/TextWorks**

- 1) Make sure all users have exited the CS/TextWorks software.
- 2) Click the CSTW9001.zip link to download and save the CS/TextWorks component of the service pack.
- 3) Unzip CSTW9001.zip to a temporary directory and run Setup.exe
- 4) When prompted for the installation directory, browse to the folder that contains your CS/TextWorks software and click “Next”.
- 5) Click the “Finish” button when Setup is complete

#### **CS/WebPublisher PRO**

- 1) If you have not done so already, stop the World Wide Web Publishing Service using your operating system's Services window.
- 2) Click the CSWPP9001.zip link to download and save the CS/WebPublisher PRO component of the service pack.
- 3) Unzip CSWPP9001.zip to a temporary directory and run Setup.exe.
- 4) When prompted for the installation directory, browse to the folder that contains your CS/WebPublisher PRO v9.0 installation.
- 4) Click the “Finish” button and restart the World Wide Web Publishing Service from the Services Window.
