

Inmagic *WebPublisher PRO* v9.00 Service Pack 2

Applying this service pack is optional. Please review the issues addressed in this service pack to determine if they are relevant to your deployment and implementation of *WebPublisher PRO* v9.00.

Purpose: To address the following issues -

1. Resolved internal error when submitting XML input that included secondary fields in the <KeyFields> section, if there was no corresponding secondary record. [SPR4342]
2. View Source on error messages now provides the product version in the version comment. [SPR 4022]
3. Edit Record no longer causes internal error WRTHTML:100 if the secondary textbase is missing and the edit form includes Link fields. [SPR 3695]
4. Using AC=TB_SCHEMA_OUTPUT no longer returns an internal error if you omit KeyFields (or FN). [SPR 3686]
5. *WebPublisher PRO* now supports ports other than the default port 80. It will now use the port number specified in the incoming URL, if specified. [SPR 1279, 4014]
6. Editing over the Web using HTTPS now works successfully. [SPR 2863]
7. The xs:appinfo element tag now uses the correct case in schema output. [SPR 3781]

The following issues were originally addressed in *WebPublisher PRO* v9.00 Service Pack 1.

1. Service Packs are cumulative; therefore, these issues are also addressed in *WebPublisher PRO* v9.00 Service Pack 2.

1. *WebPublisher* Multiple Textbase Query: Relevance ranked sorting did not work properly if the report was broken into pages [SPR 3372]
2. *WebPublisher* Multiple Textbase Query: "Record has been deleted." message when clicking Next Record on an expanded display page [SPR 3375]
3. *WebPublisher* Multiple Textbase Query: Record numbering was sometimes not continuous [SPR 3445]

Installation instructions for applying the *WebPublisher PRO* v9.00 Service Pack 2

1. Stop the World Wide Web Publishing Service using the Services window before applying this Service Pack.
2. Select and click the WPP900SP2.zip link to download and save the *WebPublisher PRO* 9.0 Service Pack 2 to your hard drive.
3. Unzip WPP900SP2.zip to a temporary directory and run Setup.exe.
4. When prompted for the installation directory, browse to the folder that contains your *WebPublisher PRO* v9.00 software and click "Next".
5. Click the "Finish" button when Setup is complete.
6. Restart the World Wide Web Publishing Service using the Services window.
